

PRAYER & WORSHIP

Question: Why do some sacraments leave a character or mark on the soul? Don't all sacraments affect the soul?

Answer: All sacraments mediate grace and connect us to Christ and to the Church. Some sustain us in our faith journey, while others help us heal from the effects of sin. Each one offers a share in God's life, giving us what we need to be faithful followers of Jesus. But some sacraments change us in ways that are irreversible. The three sacraments that leave a character are Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. We are literally different people because of the effect of the grace of those sacraments. We are changed at the core of our being in such a fundamental way that we can not go back to what we once were.

In Baptism, we are freed from original sin, initiated into the Body of Christ as adopted sons and daughters. In Confirmation, we are given the fullness of God's Spirit, sealed in his grace and gifted with what we need to live a Christian life. In Holy Orders, a priest is marked as an 'alter Christus,' another Christ, and is once and forever a priest who offers sacrifice, forgives sin, and acts in the person of Christ. In these three sacraments, we are conformed more closely to Christ, reflecting his love and truth.

During the years I was pastor of St. Patrick's Parish, Niagara Falls, Canada, I kept a framed poster in the sacristy of our church. It bore the printed challenge: "Be bearers of joy and signs of God's Presence." That small sign was a constant reminder to the other priests of St. Patrick's and to me of our special responsibility to "serve the Lord with gladness," that God's people who come to the Eucharist, even in moments of darkness and pain, can sense their Father's loving kindness.

I know how especially difficult it is for Carmelite missionaries to live that responsibility. The poor they see at Mass are almost always hungry, their sick are unattended, and their people have suffering as a way of life! Your generous gift of **\$17,800** to our missions makes their responsibility a little less difficult. It goes a long way in helping Carmelites in Peru, Mexico, El Salvador, Honduras, the Philippines, and in other parts of the underdeveloped world to feed their hungry, care for their sick and shoulder many burdens. Your goodness lets them be, in the truest sense, "bearers of joy and signs of God's Presence." How do I thank you for that!

May the Lord Jesus thank you as only He can! May Mary who gave the world its Savior keep you in her loving care!
