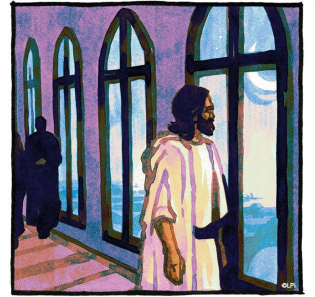

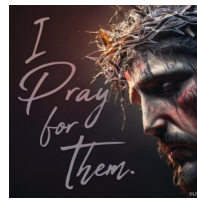
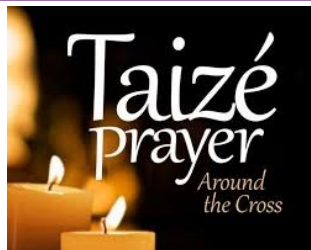
### Taizé Prayers

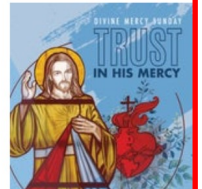

Tenebrae is a liturgical service of sung readings and Psalms that features distinctive symbolic elements of Christ's passion and death.

Candles are gradually extinguished, and a loud noise, called a "strepitus" at the service's conclusion symbolizes the chaos following Christ's death. Tenebrae is designed to serve as a powerful, reflective experience for the faithful ahead of the Easter Triduum.
