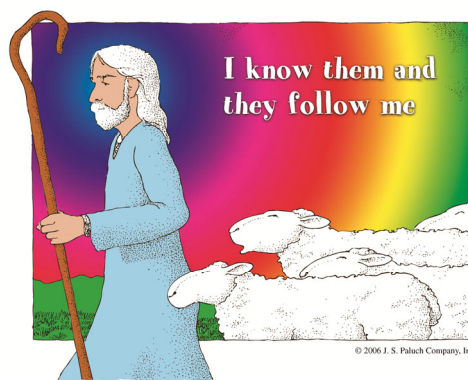
SPREADING THE WORD

In our reading from Acts today, Paul and Barnabas are on a mission to spread the word of the Lord. So they reach out to their fellow Jews in the synagogue. Many respond favorably, so many that the leaders become nervous and expel them. So Paul and Barnabas just keep going. They open up their mission to the Gentiles as well. They understand that there are some who are just not ready to hear their message, and so they leave those people, knowing that they, too, are precious to God, and that they will hear the Good News of salvation in God's time. It is such a simple message, yet so wonderful—we are saved! In the reading today from Revelation, we are assured that all who are claimed for Christ will stand with God in heaven at the eternal banquet. It is the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ, who leads us to the waters of salvation.

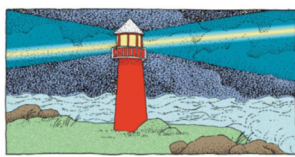
THE GOOD SHEPHERD

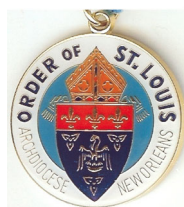

Office of Religious Education Summer 2019 Classes & Calendar ~ The Office of Religious Education will host its Summer 2019 schedule of theology courses from Saturday, June 1st through Thursday, June 27th in their office at 7887 Walmsley Avenue, New Orleans.

Each of their eight basic level courses are being offered at a variety of times that fit a person's schedule: attend either four two-and-a-half hour classes on a Monday through Thursday (morning or evening sessions available) or two five-hour classes on consecutive Saturdays. The cost of each course is \$20.

Catholic school teachers, Parish School of Religion catechists, and catechetical leaders will receive basic certification credit upon completion of each course. However, we invite anyone to consider attending our courses as part of their ongoing adult faith formation.

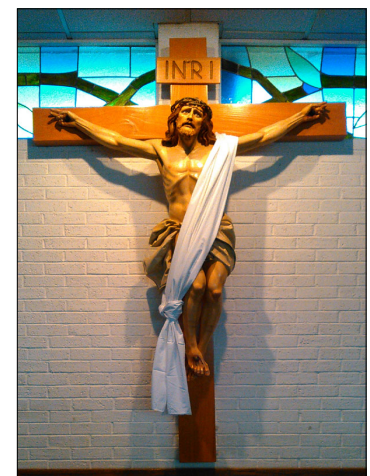
