

Formation for the Permanent Diaconate:

If you have been thinking about giving preparation for the Permanent Diaconate a try, the time tocheck this out is HERE! We will be beginning a new Discernment Group this September, 2021. We will begin with a much less formal process we are calling "Discernment Year One". If you have ever thought about becoming a Deacon but thought, "Not now", or "Maybe Later", this process might be just right for you. We will be holding eight monthly Saturday sessions in Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Feb, Mar, April, and May. If you are even MILDLY interested, or just want information about who a deacon is and what a deacon does, these sessions are for YOU. There will be no pressure to continue on to "Discernment Year Two" unless you are beginning to feel a call from God that diaconate might be for you and your family. It is during Year Two that the formal application process must be fully completed no later than January 15, 2023. We hope to offer these Saturday sessions in Durango, Alamosa, Grand Junction, and Pueblo. We may combine locations during Year One if we cannot maintain a group of at least five couples in each location.
