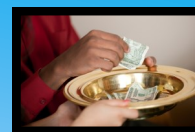

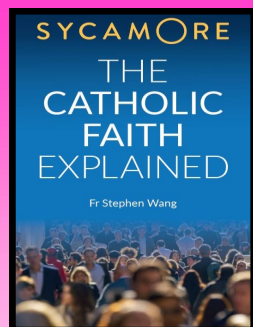

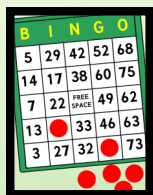

## Pro Life Rally and Walk for Life

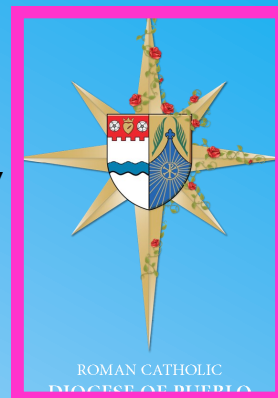
