Coats for Kids

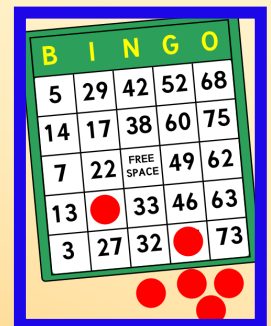

K of C BINGO

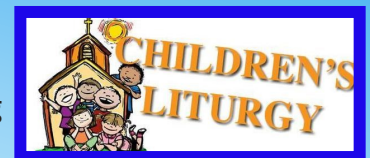
