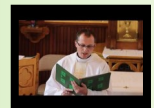
Should I go to Daily Mass?

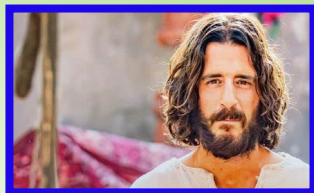

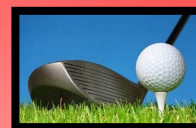

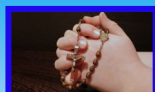
