Epiphany

The Epiphany is a Feast Day that commemorates the visit of the Magi, also known as the Three Wise Men, to the Baby Jesus. It is celebrated on January 6th, which is twelve days after Christmas. The Feast is also known as the Three Kings' Day and is celebrated in many countries around the world.



We don't know very much about the wise men. Tradition gives us their names—Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar—but not anything certain about where they were from or what they believed. We venerate them as saints—in a way, the feast of the Epiphany is also their feast day—and the reason is that the Epiphany isn't so much about Christ revealing himself to them as them revealing Christ to the world. Christ is made manifest to the gentiles not because he shows himself to the gentiles, but because the gentiles find him and state in the best way that they can—in the language of gifts—who he is. Offer your gifts of Prayer, Worship and Thanksgiving to God now and always.


