# **REQUEST FROM OUR BISHOP**

Bishop Libasci has asked all parishes in the Diocese of Manchester to gather in prayer for the current civil unrest in our country; the death of officers of Law Enforcement in Dallas, the recent sufferings of so many of Bastille Day in Nice, in Germany, the attack on the airport and subsequent attempted coup in Turkey, the many who cry out in grief and mourning in our country and throughout the world, and certainly those in the Middle East who have been relegated to the back pages of the news while their suffering nonetheless escalates daily. We continue to see other atrocities in Orlando, Baton Rouge and so in so many American cities. As we celebrate this year of Mercy, the Bishop is asking every Catholic to engage in a time of prayer. This act of Solidarity will ask us to bow before God in prayers and acts of atonement. Therefore, I direct, in accordance with the teaching, governing and sanctifying office of the diocesan bishop that:

Friday August 12, 2016 is to be a day of fast and partial abstinence (meat is eaten only once that day for all who are able and will not lightly excuse him or herself) in solidarity of faith for reparation for the sins that have brought us to this deteriorating condition of war and civil unrest. These sins are many and personal and I ask everyone to join this communal penance to make amends and to pray for the conversion of hardened hearts.

<u>Sunday August 14, 2016 The Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time:</u> Mass Prayers, Collect, Gifts, Post-Communion on this day are to be taken from The Masses For Various Needs and Occasions: *In Time of War or Civil Disturbance*.

Monday August 15, 2016 The Solemnity of The Assumption of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary: Mass is to be celebrated at 9a.m. and 7p.m. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place from the time following Mass until the evening Mass at 7p.m. The recitation of the Rosary (Luminous Mysteries) and the Litany of Loretto (Litany of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary) are to be included in this moment of devotion. The Bishop entrusts this action of solidarity in faith for atonement, reparation and healing peace to all of us
