



A good Start.....Last weekend, as we began the process of reopening our churches, I think many would agree that it was a very good start. While the number of those who came to Mass was relatively low (average of 50-60 per Mass) I believe it reflected the cautious attitude many are taking at this time. It is important that over the next weeks we continue this cautious approach as more and more people begin to feel comfortable in returning along with the increase in summer residents and visitors to the Cape. The limited amount of Masses and devotions, limited entrances and where to sit at Mass might seem to some too restrictive and unnecessary, but this is all to enable us to provide a safe environment. We literary have deployed an army of volunteers to sanitize the churches after each gathering. Without these faithful parishioners, we would not even be able to open at all. Thanks so much to them and our staff, many of whom are working 7 days a week at this point. One church this past week needed to be sanitized three times in one day because of a Mass, a funeral and confessions. And so, limiting the seating allows our volunteers to focus on specific areas of the church that have been used. No plan is perfect and we keep "tweaking" ours in order to find a good balance between safety and a return to more familiar routines in our churches. There is a reason behind everything we are doing right now, and I ask for your patience, trust and cooperation. The most important thing is that the sacraments are once again available to those who desire them. And that, my friends, is a real good start.... Have a good week. —Fr Steve





The 79th Annual Fall River Diocesan Catholic Appeal "See All the People" has begun! While delayed because of the pandemic, we cannot delay in our call to respond to those who are in need in our communities. 
