

#### Let Your Voice Be Heard – Again "Say No to ROE"

The Massachusetts state legislature has extended the session until January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Please remind the members of the Joint Committee on Judiciary that you oppose the expansion of abortion in Massachusetts. <u>Please call the Committee at 617-722-2396</u> and let them know you are opposed to H3320 and S1209 – the ROE legislation. Every telephone call helps! Remember these bills would <u>remove</u>:

- The requirement that young girls obtain consent before an abortion
- The requirement that efforts be made to save a living baby who survives abortion
- The requirement that late term abortions be performed in hospitals
- And the bills would allow abortion on demand for all nine months of pregnancy
