

Bishop da Cunha and the Bishops of the Boston Province (most dioceses in New England) have lifted the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on weekends and Holy days of Obligation beginning this weekend, June 19/20, 2021. The Bishops saw Father's Day weekend as an appropriate time to encourage families to return to the practice of Sunday Mass. Of course, the obligation DOES NOT apply to those who are ill, or recently exposed to COVID-19 or have other serious health conditions which would prohibit their attendance. Welcome back!

CATHOLIC COMMUNITY OF FALMOUTH



Bishop da Cunha has approved the recommendation of the Pastoral Council of the Catholic Community of Falmouth to unite the three parishes in Falmouth and create a new parish. Each church and chapel will retain its own name, remaining worship sites for the new parish. He has also accepted our recommendation and has named the new parish

ST. JOSEPH, GUARDIAN OF THE HOLY FAMILY.

This name was suggested by the council not only because this is the Year of St. Joseph, but also because the first Catholic parish in Falmouth, from which all the others churches and chapels were established, was St. Joseph in Woods Hole. The new parish will be for-

mally established on July 1st.

With every change, there are often many questions that arise. If you have a question regarding the establishment of our new parish, contact the parish office or email us at Strongertogether@falmouthcatholic.org and we will try to answer it. Here are a few questions that have come up.

Will the names of the churches change?

No. Beginning July 1st, the "Parish" in Falmouth will be St. Joseph, Guardian of the Holy Family. Each church and chapel will retain its proper name.

How do I make out my checks?

Contributions should be made out to "St. Joseph Parish". (There is no need to write the whole name.) Banks will continue to cash checks made out to the former parishes in Falmouth, (St. Elizabeth Seton, etc.) but only for a short time. At some point (soon), these checks will not be able to be cashed, so please start getting used to writing checks to "St. Joseph Parish."

What is the first collection each weekend for?

The first collection is for all of the operating expenses of our new parish. This includes salaries, office expenses, utilities and maintenance of all of the buildings (churches, halls, rectories, offices, etc.) The cemeteries are handled by separate accounts.

How about the 2nd collection?


These will go to specific programs and needs of the parish. Once a month, a 2nd collection is for a diocesan or national collection.

I use budget envelops. How come they don't reflect the change to a new parish?

Since we did not know the name of the new parish that would be chosen by the Bishop, we could not make the change with the envelope company that prints and distributes the envelopes in time for July 1st. We are presently working with them and hope to have the changes made in the Fall.

How about if I use on-line giving?

Still do what you normally have done. Contributions will be "pointed" to the new parish and over time will be reflected on the WeShare website.



On Saturday, July 3rd, we welcome Bishop Edgar da Cunha, the Bishop of the Fall River Diocese, to be principal celebrant at the 5:30pm Mass at St. Thomas Chapel where the Bishop will rededicate the newly renovated chapel to St. Thomas on its patronal feast day. It was also 103 years ago this weekend (July 4th) that the first Mass was celebrated in St. Thomas Chapel. We welcome all to join with us for this historic Mass.




