

MASS SCHEDULE FOR THE WINTER

For the past three years since the three Falmouth parishes formed a collaborative, the parish council and I have tried to maintain the number of Masses offered in our parish community. While we could not continue a weekend Mass at St. Joseph Chapel, we have actually provided additional opportunities for Mass on the weekend (Sunday evening, Brazilian community, extended Summer schedule at St. Thomas). None of this would have been possible without having 2 full time priests assigned to the parish and a very dedicated group of retired priests to whom I am very grateful. While I have always said that the number of Masses we have been offering would not be sustainable, this has given us time to get used to worshipping in our various churches.

As we approach the winter months, it is clear that far less parishioners attend Mass as we lose our Summer visitors and many go to warmer climates. In addition, I also lose a number of our retired priests who, like you, enjoy well deserved vacation time in retirement. We also need to realize that several of these dedicated retired priests are advanced in age as well as losing this year our beloved Fr. Phinn. This all combines to making it more difficult to maintain the present schedule. The time has come for a few changes in the Mass schedule.

With the advice and support of the Parish Council, beginning the first weekend of January, until Memorial Day weekend, the Mass schedule will be:

Saturday Vigil Masses 4pm: St. Anthony 4pm: St. Elizabeth Seton 6pm: St. Patrick- Brazilian Mass

Sunday Masses 8am: St. Anthony 9am: St. Patrick 10am: St. Elizabeth Seton 11am: St. Anthony 5pm: St. Patrick

This schedule will allow Fr. Matt and I, the only 2 priests officially assigned to the parish, to be able to cover the schedule in the event that retired priests are unavailable.

Changing a Mass schedule is one of the most difficult decisions for a pastor and his staff to make, as ultimately everyone is asked to make a sacrifice and adjust. But I believe it is time to move in this direction while at the same time providing parishioners many options to attend weekend Mass in our parish (8 Masses!). We will look at the Summer schedule for next year in the Spring. —Fr. Steve
