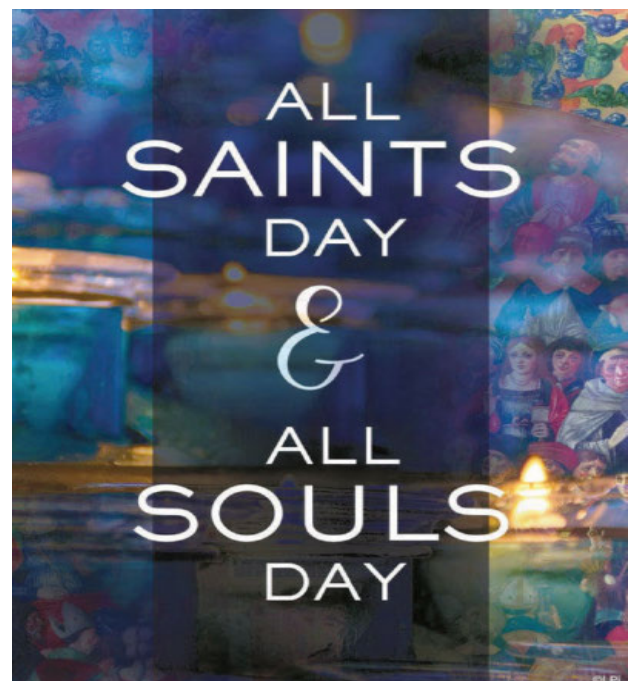
HERE TO HELP - MEN'S CLUB
