## SAINT OF THE WEEK: SAINT PAUL THE APOSTLE



St. Paul first appears in the Acts of the Apostles under the name of Saul. Saul was raised in the Jewish faith as a Pharisee trained in the strict observance of God's Law. Saul believed that the early Christians where committing blasphemy. Saul was present at and approved of the stoning of St. Stephen, the first Christian martyr (Acts 7:58).

While journeying from Jerusalem to Damascus to arrest and punish more Christians, Saul had an encounter with the risen Jesus which so changed his heart that he became convinced that fellowship with Jesus Christ, not observance of the Law, was all that was needed to receive God's promise of salvation (Galatians 1:11-12; 3:1-5).

Saul, now called "Paul," tirelessly journeyed to spread the Gospel, especially to Gentile, non-Jews, to the point of being beheaded for his faith in Rome. Paul's letters are the earliest records we have of the life of the early Church. St. Paul, pray for us!


# WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

Beginning January 18-25, the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity has a history of over 100 years, in which Christians around the world have taken part in an octave of prayer for visible Christian unity. By annually observing the WPCU, Christians move toward the fulfillment of Jesus' prayer at the Last Supper "that they all may be one." (cf. John 17:21). Pope Leo XIII was the first pope to encourage 8 days of prayer for Christian unity which has been continued ever since. Consider praying the prayer below each day!


Loving God, we ask that you grant us the spirit of wisdom and unity, so that we may be one, even as you are one with our Lord Jesus Christ - and He with you.


