



SAINT OF THE WEEK: SAINT JOHN BOSCO



Celebrated on January 31, St. John Bosco was born into a poor family in Italy in 1815. His father died when he was very young, but John became very devout and had a close relationship with Jesus early on in life. Inspired by traveling circus performers, John would use some of their tricks to build relationships with people and entertain the poor, especially children. Though he was uneducated, he felt called to priesthood and eventually was able to enter seminary and become a priest in Turin.

Turin was going through industrialization at the time, so poverty and slums were common. Fr. John worked especially hard to protect the children and youth in these conditions. He would look for work for those who did not have it, fight for the rights of young men being taken advantage of in the factories, and provide housing for the homeless.

St. John Bosco founded the Society of St. Francis de Sales which continues to help children around the world. St. John Bosco, pray for us!



THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 2






