

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. PETER



While Peter does not have an official celebration during Holy Week, the Gospel spends a lot of time on him - in one of his worst moments.

After assuring Jesus that even if all the other apostles should abandon him he, Peter, would not, Jesus tells Peter that he alone of the apostles will deny him three times that very night. And so it happens.

Unlike Judas, Peter did not despair, but trusted in Jesus' love. He sets an example for us and gives us hope that no sin is too great for Jesus to forgive if we have remorse for it. And Peter then becomes the leader of the Church! So too, no sin can stop us from accomplishing God's will, and the gravest sinners can become the greatest saints. St Peter, pray for us!






