

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST ANSELM



Anselm's memorial is celebrated on the 21st of April. Born in Italiy, Anselm's family met hardship and fluctuated between levels of devotion to their Catholic faith. Anselm himself tried to enter a monastery at age 15, but his father wouldn't give permission. Anselm quit his studies, worked in the family business, then backpacked around Europe with a friend for a few years before finally entering a monastery at age 27.

Anselm was a talented administrator, able to patiently and convincingly win others to his support. Anselm was also a talented thinker. Today he is best known for his writings on the existence of God and on why Jesus became human. He saw no disconnect between knowledge and faith; his mottos being, "Faith seeking understanding." Anselm's example should encourage us to deepen our own understanding of our faith.






