SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA



The Church celebrates the life of St. Catherine of Siena on Saturday, April 29. Born in Siena, Italy, in 1347, Catherine is one of the outstanding figures of medieval Catholicism by the strong influence she has had in the history of the papacy and her extensive authorship. She was behind the return of the Pope from Avignon, France, to Rome, and then carried out many missions entrusted to her by the pope, something quite rare for a woman of her time. Her Dialogue of Divine Providence, hundreds of letters, and dozens of prayers also give her a prominent place in Italian literature.

Catherine was named a Doctor of the Church in 1970, just days after Teresa of Avila, by St. Pope Pius VI, the second woman to be so named. Her devotion to doing God's will and courage carrying it out should inspire us today to listen closely to what God is asking of us and not to fear to carry it out. St. Catherine, pray for us!


