SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. RITA OF CASCIA



Rita's memorial is celebrated on May 22. She was born in 1381 in central Italy to a noble family who arranged her marriage to another nobleman when she was just twelve. Her husband was rich, quick tempered, unfaithful, and physically abusive to Rita and their two sons. He was eventually murdered by a rival family, but Rita gave a public pardon of his murderers, hoping to end the cycle of vendetta murders between the two families.

Rita's sons died young, so she decided to spend the last 40 years of her life as an Augustinian nun in prayer, contemplation, and service to the sick and poor. Toward the end of her life, while in prayer, a wound appeared on her forehead, as if a thorn from the crown of Christ had pierced her. She retained this wound even after her death, her body remaining incorrupt.


