SAINT OF THE WEEK: MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH



In 2018, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued a Decree implementing Pope Francis' decision that the Memorial of the "Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church" be observed on the Monday following Pentecost. The joyous veneration given to the Mother of God by the contemporary Church, in light of reflection on the mystery of Christ and on his nature, cannot ignore the figure of a woman (see Galatians 4:4), the Virgin Mary, who is both the Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church. The idea of Mary as Mother of the Church is rooted in St. John's Gospel (John 19:25-27) where, at the Crucifixion, Jesus gives Mary to the beloved disciple as his own mother. Mary, Mother of the Church, pray for us!
