SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST BONIFACE



The Church celebrates the life of St. Boniface on June 5th. Boniface was born in 675 in England with the name "Winfrid" which means, "Friend of Peace." Boniface is the religious name he received when he became a Benedictine monk.

Boniface felt called to missionary work in Germany. He established numerous monasteries and churches and worked tirelessly to spread the Gospel. He is credited with playing a key role in the Christianization of the Germanic people.

On one of their missionary journeys, Boniface and his companions were attacked and killed by robbers hoping they were traveling with treasure - all they found were books of the Bible Boniface died telling his companions to not fight back, but to overcome evil with good. St. Boniface, pray that we may treat our enemies as you did!
