SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST ANTHONY OF PADUA



St. Anthony's memorial is celebrated on June 13th, the day he died in 1231. Anthony died in Padua, Italy, but was born and raised in Lisbon, Portugal with the name Fernando de Bulhoes He is the patron saint of Portugal, of the poor, of harvests, and of lost articles. Although he died young at age 36, he lived such a holy life that he was canonized a saint less than a year after his death and was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church.

Fernando joined a religious order at age 15, but joined the newly formed Franciscan Order after being impressed by their simple way of life and took the name Anthony. He was a gifted teacher but was best known for his exceptional preaching. In fact, his preaching was so moving, that his tongue, jaw, and vocal chords were chosen as relics for veneration! St. Anthony, pray for us!


