

SAINT OF THE WEEK: MARY MAGDALENE



The Church celebrates St. Mary Magdalene's feast on July 22. Luke's Gospel tells us that Jesus healed Mary of possession by seven demons. It used to be assumed that the sinful woman who bathes Jesus feet with tears, wipes them with her hair, and anoints them with ointment, was Mary Magdalene, even though the woman is not named. Thus, Mary is often depicted holding a jar. But scholars now agree that this woman is not Mary Magdalene.

Rather, the Gospels celebrate Mary Magdalene for her faithfulness to Jesus. Mary follows Jesus on his ministry journey, stays by Jesus at the Crucifixion, prepares his body at the tomb, and is the first to see him after his Resurrection, announcing the Good News to the Apostles, earning her the title "Apostle to the Apostles." St. Mary Magdalene, pray we may be as faithful as you!

ST JOSEPH FOOD PANTRY

For many years, St Anthony's Church has maintained a Food Pantry operated out of the church basement. Several successive parishioners gave a tremendous amount of time and energy to maintain it. Each week, a brief entry in the church bulletin would identify the needs of the Pantry. Members of the parish always responded generously. Donated food was left at the church entrances and was then distributed out of the church basement.

With the formation of our new Parish, St Joseph has restructured the Food Pantry into a program that will be available to all three churches. The Food Pantry recently moved its operation into the basement of St Patrick's church. Presently, a team of volunteers works on a weekly basis to restock the shelves. It is hoped that with the move to a more central location for our community, there will be easier availability to members of all three churches.

We will continue to post a message with Pantry needs each week in the Parish bulletin. From time to time, we may suggest a size of requested items to allow for a wider distribution of food; for example, instead of one large economically priced jar of peanut butter, several smaller jars to provide for several families. In any event, we will be happy to receive any donations because the need for food and other necessities is extremely high at the moment.

In order to facilitate donations, a box marked "FOOD DONATIONS" is at the door in all three churches. Items donated will be transported on a weekly basis to St Patrick's and distributed there to those in need. We thank everyone for their continuing generosity to this project which we hope will be able to meet the needs of more people.




NEW PARISH MINISTRY: PRAYING FOR VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD


