



SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE



Saint James the Apostle, also known as St James the Greater, is celebrated by the Church on the 25th of July. St James is also often referred to as the son of Zebedee and is the brother of St John the Evangelist. St James was one of the three disciples to whom Jesus revealed the most. Often in the Gospels, Jesus goes to a private place with Peter, James and his brother John. It is these three that are present for the Transfiguration, the resurrection of a little girl, and came close to him in the Garden of Gethsemane before his passion.

Saint James is the patron of Spain and is called the "Apostle to Spain," where he went to preach the Gospel. He was bishop of and martyred in Jerusalem, from where his followers brought his body back to Spain and buried him in a place that today is the famous Santiago de Compostela Cathedral shrine where pilgrims have been walking the "Camino de Santiago" on pilgrimage for over millennia. This week, let us ask St James to pray for us and bring us ever closer to Jesus, who chose him as one of the three.

ST JOSEPH FOOD PANTRY

For many years, St Anthony's Church has maintained a Food Pantry operated out of the church basement. Several successive parishioners gave a tremendous amount of time and energy to maintain it. Each week, a brief entry in the church bulletin would identify the needs of the Pantry. Members of the parish always responded generously. Donated food was left at the church entrances and was then distributed out of the church basement.

With the formation of our new Parish, St Joseph has restructured the Food Pantry into a program that will be available to all three churches. The Food Pantry recently moved its operation into the basement of St Patrick's church. Presently, a team of volunteers works on a weekly basis to restock the shelves. It is hoped that with the move to a more central location for our community, there will be easier availability to members of all three churches.

We will continue to post a message with Pantry needs each week in the Parish bulletin. From time to time, we may suggest a size of requested items to allow for a wider distribution of food; for example, instead of one large economically priced jar of peanut butter, several smaller jars to provide for several families. In any event, we will be happy to receive any donations because the need for food and other necessities is extremely high at the moment.

In order to facilitate donations, a box marked "FOOD DONATIONS" is at the door in all three churches. Items donated will be transported on a weekly basis to St Patrick's and distributed there to those in need. We thank everyone for their continuing generosity to this project which we hope will be able to meet the needs of more people.

NEW PARISH MINISTRY: PRAYING FOR VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD



Hello everyone! It has been a great summer with you here at St. Joseph's Parish. One project that I have been asked to work on is starting a ministry here in the parish to pray for vocations to the priesthood. The concept is we will have a traveling chalice which (for now) will be found in front of the St Anthony Statue at St Anthony's church. (We hope to extend the ministry to all of our churches.) Every week a different household will sign up, take the chalice home for the week and put it somewhere of prominence. Every night the household would pray for vocations. We will start the Vocations Chalice program on the first Sunday of

August (the 5-6th). There will be a sign-up sheet in front of the St. Anthony Altar beginning next weekend, where you can sign up to take the chalice for a week. You will take the chalice after any of the weekend Masses from in front of the St Anthony statue at St Anthony's and bring it back by the start of the Vigil Mass on the following Saturday. On the sign-up sheet, we ask for your name and number so we can contact you if needed.
