

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. TERESIA



St. Teresia Benedicta a Cruce is more commonly known as St. Edith Stein. The Church celebrates her life on August 9th. Edith was born in Breslau, Germany (now Wroclaw, Poland) in 1891 in a Jewish family. Though her family was devout, she became agnostic in her teens. She was a talented student and studied philosophy under the famous founder of Phenomenology, Edmund Husserl. World War I interrupted her studies and she worked as a nurse in an infectious diseases hospital. After the war, at age 29, she read the autobiography of St. Teresa of Avila, the foundress of the Discalced Carmelites. Inspired by Teresa, she learned more about the Catholic faith and was baptized in 1922 and became a nun in 1933. With growing Nazi power, she was eventually arrested and murdered at Auschwitz in 1942. Teresia is now one of 6 patron saints of Europe. St. Teresia, pray for us!
