

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST VINCENT DE PAUL



Born on April 24, 1581, St. Vincent de Paul was the third of six children born in a poor farming family. He entered seminary at age 15, which his father paid for by selling the family oxen! He made money to continue his studies by tutoring other students and was ordained at age 19. Coming from a poor background and finding he was gifted in his studies, Vincent started his priesthood thinking he would live a rather easy, comfortable life.

Vincent had a change of heart after hearing the confession of a dying peasant. He began to organize wealthy patrons to fund his works for the poor including establishing hospitals, missionary projects, ransoming war captives, and serving the basic needs of the poor. Vincent also gave many retreats and formation for the clergy and establishing seminaries. St. Vincent, pray for us!

MASS INTENTION REQUESTS



ALLIANCE TO OPEN PREGNANCY CENTER ON CAPE COD



After surveying the services that are available on Cape Cod for women facing unplanned pregnancies, members of the Cape Cod Pro-Life Alliance found there is an unmet need for life-affirming counseling, accurate information, pregnancy support services, spiritual guidance and an outpouring of love to empower women to choose life instead of abortion. The need for such services has become acute given the State of Massachusetts doubling down on its pro-abortion agenda.

After several conversations and more importantly prayer, CCPLA and Your Options medical have chosen to partner together to establish a new life -affirming pregnancy resource center in the mid-Cape area. With a solid base of several churches already supporting Your Options Medical, our goal is to engage additional churches and individual donors to join us in ensuring long-term success.

Initially, we will provide free pregnancy testing and life-affirming options counseling through our mobile medical clinic. By launching the mobile clinic, we will be taking an innovative and strategic approach to reach women and couples in need, wherever they are. In an area as large and diverse as Cape Cod, the mobile clinic will enable us to go into different communities and help us determine the area of greatest need for a fixed location.

When you get a Choose Life Massachusetts license plate, a portion of the funds from vehicle registrations are sent to Choose Life Massachusetts and disbursed as grants to pregnancy centers like Your Options Medical.
