

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST FRANCIS OF ASSISI



Giovanni di Pietro di Bernardone was born in 1181. His name, Francis, is a nickname that his father gave him. The Church celebrates his life each year on October 4, the day of his death at age 44 in 1226. He had such a large impact on the Church that he was canonized just 2 years after his death.

But he didn't start as a saint. He lived a spoiled childhood in a wealthy merchant family. Still, he had a propensity for charity from a young age and renounced his family's wealth in his early twenties. He struggled to find his way for years, trying to discern his calling until finally realizing his call was to poverty - to be married to Lady Poverty, as he would say - and to assist and preach to the poor, encouraging all to penance, brotherly love, and peace. St. Francis of Assisi, pray for us!


