



SAINT OF THE WEEK: POPE ST. JOHN XXIII



Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was born in 1881 into a poor family of farmers in Italy; he was one of 13 children. He was ordained a priest in 1904 and received his doctorate in Canon (Church) Law. He was drafted into the Italian army during World War I and served as a chaplain and stretcher bearer in the medical corps. After the war, he served the Church in many roles and became a bishop in 1925.

He was elected pope in 1958 at age 77. The electing cardinals assumed he wouldn't do much given his advanced age, but in 1959 he called for the Second Vatican Council which started in 1962. Pope John would die before the council finished. He was declared a saint with Pope John Paul II by Pope Francis in 2014. Pope John, pray for us!


