



SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST MARTIN OF TOURS



Martin was born in Hungary around 326 AD but grew up in northern Italy. His father was an officer in the Roman military. Although Christianity had been made legal in 313, it was still a minority religion in Italy. Despite that, and against the wishes of his parents, Martin converted to Christianity in his youth. He served as a soldier, but eventually realized that he could no longer serve as a Roman soldier, saying he was now a soldier of Christ.

Martin met many hardships, he opposed the popular Arian heresy which often got him whipped or exiled. He nonetheless established a monastery to promote evangelization of the country people and was named bishop of Tours, France. He so impressed people by his holiness and his legacy endured so strongly that he is now one of the patrons of France. Given his military background, he is also the patron saint of Soldiers & Veterans. St. Martin, pray for us!


