

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY



St. Elizabeth, Princess of Hungary (1207-1231), exemplified love of God and neighbor from an early age. One episode from her childhood recalls how, going to church in royal apparel, she laid her crown at the foot of a crucifix, because she could not wear a crown when Christ was wearing thorns.

Married at age 14, but widowed at age 20, her family wished to arrange another marriage for her, which she protested. Eventually her family relented to her desire to pledge herself to a life of chastity, devotion, and service to the poor and sick.

St. Elizabeth joined the Third Order of the Franciscans, who put into practice the virtues of humility, simplicity, and charity that she had excelled in her entire life. She is patroness of the Third Order of Franciscans and is also the Patron Saint of nurses and hospitals.
