

SAINT OF THE WEEK: BLESSED MIGUEL PRO



Blessed Miguel Pro was born in Mexico in 1891 into a mining family. He entered the Jesuit novitiate in 1911. At the same time, the Mexican revolution began, which led to a massive wave of government anti-Catholicism. In 1914, the Jesuit novitiate had to dissolve and the Jesuits fled to California. Miguel continued his studies in Spain until 1919, then taught in Nicaragua for three years, then went back to finish his studies in Belgium. He was finally ordained a priest in 1925. His family was not able to be present, so he laid out all their pictures of them on his bed and blessed them "from the bottom of my heart."

Miguel returned to Mexico in 1926 during heavy persecution of the Catholic Church. Many priests in Mexico were killed during this time. Just a year after returning to Mexico, Miguel and his brothers were executed under orders of President Calle. Walking toward his death, Miguel forgave the soldiers and pronounced, "Viva Cristo Rey!" Blessed Miguel, pray our faith may be as true as yours!


