SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. GREGORY OF NAREK



Gregory was an Armenian monk, poet, and theologian. He was born around the year 950 AD and died around 1010. He came from a noble family. After his mother died, his father was ordained a bishop. Gregory was educated by his great uncle in a monastery where he would become a priest, teach at the monastery's school, and live in until his death.

Gregory is a notable figure even outside of religious circles. He is considered one of the first and best Armenian poets and his *Book of Lamentations* is considered both a spiritual and literary masterpiece. The image of Gregory to the left is from a 1173 AD illustrated manuscript of the book.

Gregory was named a doctor of the Church in 2015 by Pope Francis and has been cited by Pope St. John Paul II in his encyclicals as well as by the Catechism of the Catholic Church (article 2678). His feast day is February 27. St. Gregory, pray for us!

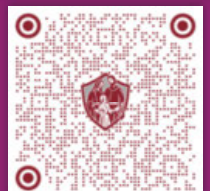

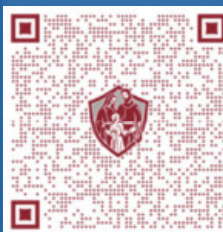
