

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. BENEDICT JOSEPH LABRE



Benedict Joseph, the oldest of 15 children, was born into a prosperous French family in 1748. He spent much of his childhood with his uncle, a parish priest, who educated him. He tried to enter numerous religious orders, but was refused for various reasons from being too young to not being healthy enough. In his mid twenties he joined the Third Order Franciscans and committed himself to a life of poverty and pilgrimage.

With a crucifix, rosary, and backpack, Benedict became a "Fool for Christ" as it is called in the Orthodox Tradition. Benedict spent his life in prayer, visiting as many shrines and holy places in Europe as he could; never working, just living on alms he was given. The patron saint of the homeless, Benedict gives us an example of how fruitful an "unproductive" life can be. St. Benedict, pray for us!


