

## THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS



The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (instituted in 1856 by Pope Pius IX) is celebrated on Friday after the Solemnity of Corpus Christi in order for us to see that the Eucharist (Corpus Christi) is none other than the Heart of Jesus, the One who “takes care of us” with his “heart.”

Devotion to the Sacred Heart became popular thanks to the revelations of our Lord to Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690). In 1673 she received a vision in which Jesus told her, “My Divine Heart is so passionately in love with humanity that it can no longer contain within itself the flames of its ardent love. It must pour them out.” In 1995 Saint John Paul II instituted the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests on this same day so that the priesthood might be protected in Jesus’ heart and be open to everyone. Sacred Heart of Jesus, graciously hear our prayers!



### **WELCOME, SEMINARIAN KAIQUE DUARTE SANTOS!**

We are honored to have a seminarian join us this summer! Please extend a warm welcome to Kaique (Kai-EE-kay) when you see him around the parish. In his own words, “I was born in Brazil, the youngest of three children. My mother was a teacher, and my father was a gemstone cutter. As a child, I was curious and imaginative, with dreams of becoming a scientist or a doctor, and I developed a keen interest in American culture.

My teenage years were marked by profound loss; my brother, Victor, died in a tragic accident in 2008, followed by the death of my father just two months later in 2009. These events led me to question the meaning of life and created a spiritual questioning.

However, a youth retreat in 2010 marked a significant turning point, leading to a profound experience of Jesus' love and a personal encounter with Him. It was during another retreat in 2011, inspired by the joyful witness of a young priest, that the idea of dedicating my entire life to God through the priesthood first filled me with peace and excitement.

My path to the priesthood has been one of deep discernment. This journey also involved navigating the grief of my mother's passing. A pivotal moment came after a trip to Europe, where I felt a strong missionary call to serve the Church where there is a great need for priests. Through a friend, I learned about the Diocese of Fall River and its Brazilian bishop, and I was warmly welcomed into the diocese in 2023. With a heart full of peace and joy, I continue my journey toward becoming a priest after the Heart of Jesus. I am greatly looking forward to my summer assignment at St. Joseph, Guardian of the Holy Family Parish. I am eager to serve the parish community and share the love of Christ that has so profoundly shaped my own life and vocation.

## **BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST NOVENA**

### **ENDING JUNE 30, ST. ANTHONY, 6 PM HOLY HOUR**

**Daily Opening Prayer:** Make the Sign of the Cross

**Daily Reflection:** See below for each day.

**Daily Closing Prayer:** O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen

#### **DAY 1: THE CREATION OF THE WORLD**

We recall the blessing of creation, which Christ takes up, transforms, and presents to his heavenly Father.

“God also said: See, I give you every seed-bearing plant on all the earth and every tree that has seed-bearing fruit on it to be your food.” GENESIS 1:29

You make the plants to serve mankind’s need. That he may bring forth bread from the earth and wine to cheer the heart. - Jesus, Lord of Creation, grant us the grace to offer ourselves, our works, and all creation in union with you to the Father.

#### **DAY 2: THE FEAST OF PASSOVER**

We recall our definitive liberation from sin in Christ, our Passover who has been sacrificed.

“On the tenth of this month every family must procure for itself a lamb, one apiece for each household.” EX. 12:3  
The cup of salvation I will raise; I will call on the name of the Lord. - Jesus, Lamb of God, grant us the grace to cast out the old yeast of malice and wickedness, and to live in sincerity and truth.

#### **DAY 3: THE MANNA IN THE DESERT**

We recall the foretaste of the heavenly Kingdom, which we receive in the Eucharist.

“Then the LORD said to Moses: I am going to rain down bread from heaven for you.” EXODUS 16:4

But Israel I would feed with finest wheat; and satisfy them with honey from the rock. - Jesus, Holy Manna, grant us the grace to set our minds on things above rather than on things of earth.

#### **DAY 4: THE NATIVITY OF CHRIST**

We recall that the Word who became flesh and dwelt among us now gives himself to us in the Eucharist.

“Mary gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.” LUKE 2:7

I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever. - Jesus, Bread of Life, grant that we, nourished by the Eucharist, may hasten to you in the poor, the suffering, and the persecuted.

#### **DAY 5: THE INSTITUTION OF THE EUCHARIST**

We recall the gift of the Eucharist, which Jesus entrusted to the Church.

“Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, ‘This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me.’ And likewise the cup... ‘This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you.’” LUKE 22:19-20

I will offer you a thanksgiving sacrifice; I will call on the name of the LORD. - Jesus, Mediator of the New Covenant, grant us the grace to cherish the worship you established at the Last Supper.

#### **DAY 6: THE SACRIFICE OF THE CROSS**

We recall Christ’s gift of himself upon the cross, the wellspring of the Church’s Sacraments.

“But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs, but one soldier thrust his lance into his side, and immediately blood and water flowed out.” JOHN 19:33-34

Into your hands I commend my spirit. You will redeem me, O LORD, O faithful God. - Jesus, Eternal High Priest, grant us the grace to offer our lives as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to you. Amen.

#### **DAY 7: THE RESURRECTION**

We recall Christ’s triumph over sin and death.

“While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight.” LUKE 24:30-31

You will show me the path of life, the fullness of joy in your presence. - Jesus, Source of New Life, set our hearts on fire with the gift of your Spirit, and grant us the grace to proclaim your risen life. Amen.

#### **DAY 8: THE EUCHARIST IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH**

The Church’s life flows from the Eucharist & returns to it.

“They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers.” ACTS 2:42

Taste and see that the LORD is good. Blessed the man who seeks refuge in him. - Jesus, Lord of the Church, grant that by partaking of your Body and Blood we may become one body and one spirit in you. Amen.

#### **DAY 9: THE WEDDING FEAST OF THE LAMB**

We recall the ultimate fulfillment of the Eucharist in the wedding feast of heaven.

“I confer a kingdom on you, just as my Father has conferred one on me, that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom.” LUKE 22:29-30

You have prepared a table before me; my cup is overflowing. - Jesus, Holy Banquet, be our food for the journey, that we may join the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the angels and saints in your kingdom. Amen.


