

The Church celebrates Saints Peter & Paul on June 29, the traditional day of their martyrdom in Rome in the year 64. St. Peter is depicted holding a set of keys, a reference to Matthew 16:19. St. Paul holds up a book, the symbol of his many letters. Both adore Jesus, illuminated by the Holy Spirit.

Saints Peter and Paul are symbolic pillars of the Church. St. Peter, the Vicar of Christ, represents the ever present ministry and authority of Jesus on earth. Volunteers must have at least already made their First Communion and must be physically capable of carrying a processional cross and performing other similar physical tasks.



CONGRATULATIONS DR. PAUL DEMEO! INSTALLED TO THE ORDER OF LECTOR



Paul Edward DeMeo, who is
currently studying for the Fall
River Permanent Diaconate, was
installed to the Order of Lector
by Most Reverend Edgar M da
Cunha, S.D.V. Bishop of Fall River,
on Tuesday evening, June 24,
2025.

The Ministry of Lector is the first of two
ministries which candidates must receive and
exercise as part of their preparation for
ordination as permanent deacons.

This is the eleventh class for the Permanent
Diaconate of the Diocese of Fall River and they
have been in the formation program for three
years. They will continue two more years of
academic and pastoral formation before
ordination as deacons.

JUBILEE 2025 INFORMATION



For the Jewish people, a Jubilee year was held every 49 years - and extra year in between 7 cycles of 7 years (cf. Leviticus 25:8-13). It was intended to be a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. It involved forgiving debts, returning misappropriated land, and a fallow period for the fields.

The Catholic Church has celebrated Jubilee years, usually every 25 years, since the 1300s. Pope Francis inaugurated Jubilee Year 2025 on Christmas Eve with the theme, "Pilgrims of Hope," seeking to inspire hope around the world. Bishop Edgar has celebrated a special Mass to open the local diocesan observance of the Jubilee. Bishop Edgar has designated 3 pilgrimage sites for the faithful to visit to participate in the Jubilee including:

- + The Cathedral of St Mary, Fall River
- + Our Lady of Mount Carmel, New Bedford
- + St. Francis Xavier, Hyannis
