

# SAINT OF THE WEEK: AUGUSTINE ZHAO RONG



Augustine Zhao Rong and other martyrs of China, are celebrated on July 9. In the late 1700s Zhao Rong was assigned to the company of guards sent to escort the French missionary, Bishop John Dufresse, to his execution in Beijing. Impressed by the Bishop's spirit, Zhao began to listen to this leader of an outlawed faith. Soon, the soldier asked for baptism, taking the name Augustine. Augustine Zhao Rong later asked for holy orders, becoming the first Chinese-born diocesan priest. In 1815, Fr. Augustine was also tortured and martyred. 87 Chinese Christians were also martyred after him. They were all beatified together in 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II.



Paul Edward DeMeo, who is currently studying for the Fall River Permanent Diaconate, was installed to the Order of Lector by Most Reverend Edgar M da Cunha, S.D.V. Bishop of Fall River, on Tuesday evening, June 24, 2025.

The Ministry of Lector is the first of two ministries which candidates must receive and exercise as part of their preparation for ordination as permanent deacons.

This is the eleventh class for the Permanent Diaconate of the Diocese of Fall River and they have been in the formation program for three years. They will continue two more years of academic and pastoral formation before ordination as deacons.

## JUBILEE 2025 INFORMATION



For the Jewish people, a Jubilee year was held every 49 years - and extra year in between 7 cycles of 7 years (cf. Leviticus 25:8-13). It was intended to be a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. It involved forgiving debts, returning misappropriated land, and a fallow period for the fields.

The Catholic Church has celebrated Jubilee years, usually every 25 years, since the 1300s. Pope Francis inaugurated Jubilee Year 2025 on Christmas Eve with the theme, "Pilgrims of Hope," seeking to inspire hope around the world. Bishop Edgar has celebrated a special Mass to open the local diocesan observance of the Jubilee. Bishop Edgar has designated 3 pilgrimage sites for the faithful to visit to participate in the Jubilee including:

- + The Cathedral of St Mary, Fall River
- + Our Lady of Mount Carmel, New Bedford
- + St. Francis Xavier, Hyannis


