

SAINT OF THE WEEK: OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL



The first Carmelites were hermits living on Mount Carmel in the Holy Land during the late 12th and early to mid-13th century. They built a chapel amidst their hermitages which they dedicated to the Blessed Virgin.

Since then, the order grew and spread all over the world. Many famous saints have been Carmelites, the reformers, Teresa of Avila and John of the Cross, Therese of Lisieux (the Little Flower), and Teresa of the Cross (Edith Stein who was killed at Auschwitz), to name a few. Even Pope Leo's grandmother was a Third Order Carmelite! Our Lady of Mount Carmel, pray for us!



Pope Leo Promoting Care for Creation with new Proper Prayers for Mass

On July 9, Pope Leo celebrated the first Mass "For the Care of Creation" with the staff of the Borgo Laudato Si - a space for education and training in integral ecology hosted in the gardens of the papal villa at Castel Gandolfo. The Mass includes proper prayers and readings that show the link between justice, care for creation, and communion with God and each other. It calls us to be faithful stewards of what God has entrusted to us - not only in daily choices and public policies, but also in our prayer, worship, and way of living in the world. There are currently 49 different Masses and prayers for various needs and occasions. Pope Leo has also designated September 1 as World Day of Prayer for Creation. Our parish will celebrate Care for Creation through the month of September with a variety of opportunities to learn more about Pope Francis' and Pope Leo's focus on creation.

MARONITE RITE MASS

Join us at St. Joseph Chapel on Wednesday, July 16 at 5pm as Fr. Steve's seminary classmate and New Bedford native, Chorbishop Michael Thomas celebrates Mass for us in the Maronite tradition!

The Maronite Church is one of 22 Eastern Rites of the Catholic Church, under the authority of the Pope. It dates back to the early Christians of Antioch (Syria) where Jesus' followers "were called Christians for the first time" (Acts 11:26). The actual name "Maronite" is derived from the name of Saint Maron, who was a priest and hermit, and died around the year 410 AD.

As part of the Roman Catholic Church, the Maronites profess the same beliefs in the Dogmatic and Moral teachings of the Church and celebrate the same seven Sacraments. Their liturgical celebrations are more unique and reflect their early Apostolic beginnings. For example, in some prayers and hymns of the Mass, the Maronites still use Syriac, a dialect of the Aramaic language spoken by Jesus and his Apostles, and incense is regularly used. During the civil and religious persecutions of the 7th century, the Maronites fled their churches and monasteries in the plains of Syria, and took refuge in the verdant mountains and caves of nearby Lebanon. Since then, Lebanon has been considered the homeland of the Maronite Church.

Millions of Maronites now live in various countries throughout the world, but their Mother Church remains in Lebanon. The current Maronite Patriarch, Bechara Peter Rai, was made a Cardinal by Pope Benedict XVI, in November of 2012. Cardinal Rai lives at the Maronite Patriarchal residence in Bkerke, Lebanon. The United States is home to two Maronite Eparchies (Dioceses). Bishop Gregory Mansour is the Bishop of the Eastern Eparchy, resides in Brooklyn, NY and is a member of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), as is the Bishop of the Western Eparchy, the Most Reverend Elias Zaidan who resides in Los Angeles.
