

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST MARY MAGDELENE



Mary Magdalene is often confused with the sinful woman of Luke 7 who anoints Jesus feet, wiping them with her hair, but that is very likely a different person. Mary Magdalene was the woman from whom Jesus cast seven demons. This led her to continue following Jesus, even to his crucifixion.

Most famously, Mary Magdalene is the first person to see the Resurrected Jesus. He sends her to tell the other apostles that he has risen; she is therefore known as the Apostle of the Apostles. Her feast day is July 22. She is the patroness of converts and repentant sinners. St. Mary, pray for us!



Directions on quantities, how to treat, cut, and deliver will be on those signup clipboards. Thank you for helping make our worship beautiful!





On July 9, Pope Leo celebrated the first Mass "For the Care of Creation" with the staff of the Borgo Laudato Si - a space for education and training in integral ecology hosted in the gardens of the papal villa at Castel Gandolfo.

The Mass includes proper prayers and readings that show the link between justice, care for creation, and communion with God and each other. It calls us to be faithful stewards of what God has entrusted to us - not only in daily choices and public policies, but also in our prayer, worship, and way of living in the world. There are currently 49 different Masses and prayers for various needs and occasions.

Pope Leo has also designated September 1 as World Day of Prayer for Creation. Our parish will celebrate Care for Creation through the month of September with a variety of opportunities to learn more about Pope Francis' and Pope Leo's focus on taking care of our common home.
