



## SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. VICTOR I



Victor was born in the 100s AD in Northern Africa, then a province of the Roman Empire. He was made bishop of pope around 189 AD until his death in 199. At that time, the emperor and Romans in general treated Christians well.

Victor is most known for enforcing a universal date for Easter. Some Christians in Asia Minor (now Turkey) celebrated Easter on the 14th day of the Jewish month of Nisan (the date of Passover in the Book of Exodus), even when that day did not fall on Sunday. Victor made it a rule to always celebrate Easter on Sunday.

Greek had been the common language in the Church for celebrating Mass. Victor changed this and started using Latin in Rome so that people could pray in their own language. St. Victor, pray for us!





Directions on quantities, how to treat, cut, and deliver will be on those signup clipboards. Thank you for helping make our worship beautiful!





## JUBILEE 2025 INFORMATION



For the Jewish people, a Jubilee year was held ever 49 years - and extra year in between 7 cycles of 7 years (cf. Leviticus 25:8-13). It was intended to be a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with

one another, and with all of creation. It involved forgiving debts, returning misappropriated land, and a fallow period for the fields.

The Catholic Church has celebrated Jubilee years, usually every 25 years, since the 1300s. Pope Francis inaugurated Jubilee Year 2025 on Christmas Eve with the theme, "Pilgrims of Hope," seeking to inspire hope around the world. Bishop Edgar has celebrated a special Mass to open the local diocesan observance of the Jubilee. Bishop Edgar has designated 3 pilgrimage sites for the faithful to visit to participate in the Jubilee including:

- + The Cathedral of St Mary, Fall River
- + Our Lady of Mount Carmel, New Bedford
- + St. Francis Xavier, Hyannis
