

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. JANE FRANCES DE CHANTAL



Jane Frances was wife, mother, nun, and founder of a religious community. Jane developed into a woman of beauty and refinement, lively and cheerful in temperament. At 21, she married Baron de Chantal, by whom she had six children, three of whom died in infancy. After just 7 years of marriage, her husband also died, and she sank into deep dejection.

When she was 32, Jane met Saint Francis de Sales who became her spiritual director. Francis wanted to found an institute of women otherwise barred from entering already established communities. At age 45, Frances became one of the first members. Despite continued suffering, loss, and spiritual dryness, she continued to serve the poor. St. Jane, pray for us!



### **INVOCATION WEEKEND**

This weekend, all parishes in our diocese are focusing on vocations to the priesthood, especially in our diocese. At Masses, Kaique Santos, who has been serving here this summer and John Turner, a parishioner who has been recently accepted into the seminary formation process, will speak at Masses about their vocation journey and request for prayers as they discern their call to the priesthood. John joins 4 other young men who are entering the seminary this year!

Here in our parish, we have 2 initiatives to support priests and those preparing for the priesthood: The Seven Sisters Apostolate and the Priesthood Vocation Chalice (see info below). In addition, there are cards in the pews providing ideas on how you can foster vocations by your prayers and encouragement of young men. Please take a card with you. Let us all pray for priestly vocations.

### **SEVEN SISTERS APOSTOLATE**

The Seven Sisters Apostolate is an international ministry whose mission is to encourage prayer for our priests. In our parish, we are hoping to have at least 14 women pray for Fr. Bryan and Fr. 
