

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. HILDEGARD OF BINGEN



St. Hildegard of Bingen was declared a doctor of the Church in 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. She is first in a line of mystical saints from Germany; Hildegard was a poet, prophet, physician, and political advocate who fearlessly gave advice to popes and princes. Born in 1098, Hildegard felt called to religious life at an early age and lived with a Hermitess near her parents home. Other women joined them, and when the Hermitess died, Hildegard was elected to lead the community.

Hildegard suffered from chronic illness, but traveled throughout Europe visiting and reforming monasteries and wrote prolifically. Her writings include mystical visions she received from God as well as music and letters. St. Hildegard, pray for us!

SEASON OF CREATION

CELEBRATING THE GIFT OF CREATION GOD HAS GIVEN US

The Season of Creation is a time to renew our relationship with our Creator and all creation through celebration, conversion, and commitment together. During the Season of Creation, we join our sisters and brothers in the ecumenical family in prayer and action for our common home.

Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I proclaimed 1 September as a day of prayer for creation for the Orthodox in 1989. In fact, the Orthodox church year starts on that day with a commemoration of how God created the world.

The World Council of Churches was instrumental in making the special time a season, extending the celebration from 1 September and ends 4 October, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology beloved by many Christian denominations..

Following the leadership of Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I and the WCC, Christians worldwide have embraced the season as part of their annual calendar. Pope Francis established the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation in the Roman Catholic Church in 2015, and in 2019 started celebrating the Season of Creation as well. Pope Leo has continued to encourage care for creation, recently calling environmental justice, “an urgent need that involves much more than simply protecting the environment... it is a matter of justice.”

Our parish is participating by officially launching our Creation Care Ministry and holding two opportunities to learn and discuss care for creation. To learn more, contact the ministry head, Dr. Paul Skudder at:
