SAINT OF THE WEEK: MICHAEL, GABRIEL, AND RAFAEL, ARCHANGELS



The Catholic Church confirms the existence of angels, and that they are active in our lives. So, what is an angel? What is an archangel? And what makes them so special? The Catechism states, "The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls 'angels' is a truth of faith," (CCC, paragraph 328). The word, "angel," comes from the Greek word, "angelos," which means, "messenger." The Bible and the Church recognizes seven archangels, although just three are known by name, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. The name Michael means "one who is like God," Gabriel means "God is my strength," and Raphael means "God is my health." In this image, they are depicted presenting Jesus, showing their role as his messengers.

LECTOR MINISTRY





REALLY PRESENT, REALLY THANKFUL!

BEING ATTENTIVE TO THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE EUCHARIST

Many recent surveys have shown that even Catholics are confused about the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist or do not believe in it at all. What can we do about this problem? It can feel overwhelming as one individual to try and encourage a proper understanding of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. And for those of us who do believe and attend Mass often, it can be easy to forget how amazing it is that God is really among us, is really present in such a real and intimate way. In this weekly column, we will present Church teaching on the Eucharist as well as some practical suggestions we can all do to help us better appreciate the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist!

Catholics are not the only Christians who believe the Real Presence. Below is an Orthodox Icon showing John the Baptist pointing to the baby Jesus lying in a ciborium holding a scroll that reads, "Behold the Lamb." Just as John saw Jesus in the flesh, so too at Mass when the priest says, "Behold the Lamb" and holds up the Eucharist, he is doing for us just what John the Baptist - did pointing out Jesus in the flesh!



PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE & END OF LIFE CARE

What Should Christian Do?

How does a Christian approach issues at the end of life? This presentation will examine some of the basic moral principles that help to guide us in medical decision-making, and assist us in helping our loved ones to live out their final days with the true dignity each human person deserves. Particular issues such as physician-assisted suicide, MOLST, and the importance of having a Christian HealthCare Proxy will also be included. The presentation will include an opportunity for Q &A and materials will be available.

Fr Tad is an engaging and insightful speaker. He writes and speaks widely on bioethics and medical ethics. He currently serves as Senior Ethicist at The National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia. Since 2001, he has given several hundred presentations and invited lectures, and participated in debates and roundtables on contemporary bioethics throughout the US, Canada and Europe.
