SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI



Small in stature and having an extrovert personality, Francis always had in his heart the desire to do great things. He demonstrated this in his 20s when he left for the war between Assisi and Perugia, and later to help end the conflict of the crusades. Upon his return, hearing God speaking to him in prayer, Francis sought a different path to great deeds. The joy unleashed by feeling loved and called by God led Francis to declare his desire to marry “Lady Poverty” and renounce his worldly securities.

Famous for many things, Francis had a deep love of Christ that showed visibly: pictured to the left is Francis receiving the wounds of Christ in his own body. Francis is the patron of animals, ecologists, & peace. His feast day is Oct. 4, the day of his death.

This presentation will examine some of the basic moral principles that help to guide us in medical decision-making, and assist us in helping our loved ones to live out their final days with the true dignity each human person deserves. The presentation will include an opportunity for Q&A and materials will be available.

He currently serves as Senior Ethicist at The National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia. 
