

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. LUKE, EVANGELIST



The feast of St. Luke is celebrated on October 18. He is believed to be the author of both the Gospel of Luke and of the Acts of the Apostles. He is mentioned in the New Testament, especially in the St. Paul's letter to the Colossians, where Paul calls him a physician. There is also a tradition that St. Luke painted the first image of Mary with Jesus. Thus, in art, Luke is often depicted with an image of Mary and Jesus, as well as with or as an Ox (one of four animal symbols assigned to the Gospel writers), and writing or with a book (a symbol of his writing a Gospel).

Appropriately, Luke's Gospel contains the most stories of Jesus healing people and the most stories with Mary; only Luke tells about the Annunciation and the Magnificat. St. Luke, pray for us!





REALLY PRESENT, REALLY THANKFUL!

LIVING AS A EUCHARISTIC CHURCH: YOU ARE WHAT YOU EAT & WHAT YOU DO!

The Second Vatican Council explained that the Sacraments both sanctify us and instruct us; they make us holy and teach us about holiness. They not only presuppose faith, but by words and objects they also nourish, strengthen, and express faith (Catechism, #1123).

When the Church celebrates the sacraments, she confesses the faith received from the apostles - whence the ancient saying: *lex orandi, lex credendi* (the law of prayer is the law of faith). The Church believes as she prays (Catechism, #1124). In other words, the way we pray shows what we believe, and what we believe should affect the way that we pray. Whether prayer is expressed in words or gestures, it is the whole person who prays. In Scripture, it is the heart that prays. If our heart is far from God, the words of prayer are in vain (Catechism, #2562).

Pope Benedict XVI said that "A heart reconciled to God makes genuine participation [in liturgy] possible" (Sacramentum Caritatis, 55). The Church's great liturgical tradition teaches us that fruitful participation in the liturgy requires that one be personally conformed to the mystery being celebrated, offering one's life to God in unity with the sacrifice of Christ for the salvation of the whole world (Sacramentum Caritatis, 64).

Our interior dispositions must correspond to our gestures and words. Otherwise, however good our Masses may be, we risk turning Mass into a show, performing actions without believing they do anything to us - our prayer becomes disconnected from our belief.

St. Augustine said that if we receive the body and blood of Jesus properly then we are what we have received, "not only have we become Christians, we have become Christ himself." Receiving the Eucharist alone is not enough to be like Christ. We must also worship and live like Jesus. We'll explore how in future weeks!
