

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. ALONSO RODRIGUEZ



Born into a wealthy family of cloth merchants in 1533 in Segovia, Spain, Alonso's father died young, but he led an ordinary life, helping run the family business, marrying at age 27, and having three children. All this changed when his wife & all of his children died and heavy taxes destroyed his family business within 10 years.

Alonso dedicated his life to mortification and prayer, seeing himself a failure. Even when he was admitted into the Society of Jesus, he was not allowed to be a priest because he was not educated. He was given the role of Porter as a lay brother, answering the door of the Jesuit house, and doing simple errands and giving alms. Yet, for the next 46 years as Porter, his holy simplicity changed many lives. His feast day is October 31.



The Second Vatican Council explained that the Sacraments both sanctify us and instruct us; they make us holy and teach us about holiness. They not only presuppose faith, but by words and objects they also nourish, strengthen, and express faith (Catechism, #1123).

When the Church celebrates the sacraments, she confesses the faith received from the apostles - whence the ancient saying: *lex orandi, lex credendi* (the law of prayer is the law of faith). The Church believes as she prays (Catechism, #1124). In other words, the way we pray shows what we believe, and what we believe should affect the way that we pray. Whether prayer is expressed in words or gestures, it is the whole person who prays. In Scripture, it is the heart that prays. If our heart is far from God, the words of prayer are in vain (Catechism, #2562).

Pope Benedict XVI said that "A heart reconciled to God makes genuine participation [in liturgy] possible" (Sacramentum Caritatis, 55). The Church's great liturgical tradition teaches us that fruitful participation in the liturgy requires that one be personally conformed to the mystery being celebrated, offering one's life to God in unity with the sacrifice of Christ for the salvation of the whole world (Sacramentum Caritatis, 64).

Our interior dispositions must correspond to our gestures and words. Otherwise, however good our Masses may be, we risk turning Mass into a show, performing actions without believing they do anything to us - our prayer becomes disconnected from our belief.

St. Augustine said that if we receive the body and blood of Jesus properly then we are what we have received, "not only have we become Christians, we have become Christ himself." Receiving the Eucharist alone is not enough to be like Christ. We must also act like Jesus.
