CALLED BY NAME: HELPING THE HOLY SPIRIT INCREASE PRIESTLY VOCATIONS

Dear Friends in Christ, Grace and Peace to you in our Lord Jesus Christ! As your bishop, one of my greatest responsibilities is to ensure that the faithful of our Diocese will always have good and holy priests to shepherd them. And yet, priestly vocations are never the work of one person alone. They arise when the whole Church prays for, encourages, and calls forth those men whom God has chosen.

For this reason, our Diocese is once again hosting **Called by Name on November 8-9**, during which I ask you to help me identify young men who demonstrate faith, generosity and leadership. You may recall this initiative from last year, through which the Vocation Office received 164 submissions. We have seen tremendous fruit from this effort, with more men in discernment groups, attending events, and being accompanied by our Vocation Team. Thanks be to God, we accepted five new seminarians and many more are in serious discernment.

We now have nine men in formation for the priesthood for the 2025-2026 academic year. Yet, our overall goal is to attain and maintain 25 seminarians for the Diocese of Fall River so we can ordain enough priests to staff our parishes and provide the sacraments to our faith communities. To continue this momentum, we want to connect with even more incredible young men this year! I invite you to nominate young men in your community who live their faith with integrity, serve generously, and show potential for Christian leadership. Your nomination may be the spark that helps a young man open his heart more fully to God's call. Don't hesitate to nominate a young man again, we want to continue to support him.

You may use the cards provided at Mass or submit names online at fallrivervocatoins.org. For those under 18 please include their parents' names as well. This effort is dear to my heart. With your thoughtful participation, I am confident the Lord will raise up many new shepherds for his people. May this campaign bear lasting fruit for our Diocese and for the salvation of souls. — Most Reverend Edgar M da Dunha, SDV

The Second Vatican Council explained that the Sacraments both sanctify us and instruct us; they make us holy and teach us about holiness. They not only presuppose faith, but by words and objects they also nourish, strengthen, and express faith (Catechism, #1123).

When the Church celebrates the sacraments, she confesses the faith received from the apostles - whence the ancient saying: *lex orandi, lex credendi* (the law of prayer is the law of faith). The Church believes as she prays (Catechism, #1124). In other words, the way we pray shows what we believe, and what we believe should affect the way that we pray. Whether prayer is expressed in words or gestures, it is the whole person who prays. In Scripture, it is the heart that prays. If our heart is far from God, the words of prayer are in vain (Catechism, #2562).

Pope Benedict XVI said that "A heart reconciled to God makes genuine participation [in liturgy] possible" (Sacramentum Caritatis, 55). The Church's great liturgical tradition teaches us that fruitful participation in the liturgy requires that one be personally conformed to the mystery being celebrated, offering one's life to God in unity with the sacrifice of Christ for the salvation of the whole world (Sacramentum Caritatis, 64).

Our interior dispositions must correspond to our gestures and words. Otherwise, however good our Masses may be, we risk turning Mass into a show, performing actions without believing they do anything to us - our prayer becomes disconnected from our belief.

St. Augustine said that if we receive the body and blood of Jesus properly then we are what we have received, "not only have we become Christians, we have become Christ himself." Receiving the Eucharist alone is not enough to be like Christ. We must also act like Jesus.


