SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. JOSAPHAT



St. Josaphat's feast day is November 12. Born in Poland in the late 1500s, he was raised in the Ukrainian Orthodox Church. He became a monk and then was made bishop of what is now Poland, Lithuania, and Ukraine. At this point in history, the Orthodox and Catholic Churches had split. After the split, some Orthodox bishops decided to return their allegiance to the Pope rather than the Patriarch of Constantinople, but to keep their liturgical traditions. Josaphat strongly desired union between the two Churches, which was not a popular view at the time, and worked hard to encourage union. He was martyred in 1623 by a mob that disagreed with his desire for reunion. He is the first formally canonized saint of the Eastern Rite. St. Josaphat, pray for us!

CREATION CARE MINISTRY



CALLED BY NAME: HELPING THE HOLY SPIRIT INCREASE PRIESTLY VOCATIONS



Dear Friends in Christ, Grace and Peace to you in our Lord Jesus Christ! As your bishop, one of my greatest responsibilities is to ensure that the faithful of our Diocese will always have good and holy priests to shepherd them. And yet, priestly vocations are never the work of one person alone. They arise when the

whole Church prays for, encourages, and calls forth those men whom God has chosen.

For this reason, our Diocese is once again hosting **Called by Name on November 8-9**, during which I ask you to help me identify young men who demonstrate faith, generosity and leadership. You may recall this initiative from last year, through which the Vocation Office received 164 submissions. We have seen tremendous fruit from this effort, with more men in discernment groups, attending events, and being accompanied by our Vocation Team. Thanks be to God, we accepted five new seminarians and many more are in serious discernment.

We now have nine men in formation for the priesthood for the 2025-2026 academic year. Yet, our overall goal is to attain and maintain 25 seminarians for the Diocese of Fall River so we can ordain enough priests to staff our parishes and provide the sacraments to our faith communities. To continue this momentum, we want to connect with even more incredible young men this year! I invite you to nominate young men in your community who live their faith with integrity, serve generously, and show potential for Christian leadership. Your nomination may be the spark that helps a young man open his heart more fully to God's call. Don't hesitate to nominate a young man again, we want to continue to support him.

You may use the cards provided at Mass or submit names online at fallrivervocatoins.org. For those under 18 please include their parents' names as well. This effort is dear to my heart. With your thoughtful participation, I am confident the Lord will raise up many new shepherds for his people. May this campaign bear lasting fruit for our Diocese and for the salvation of souls.

HOW-TO CATHOLIC

LIVING AS A EUCHARISTIC CHURCH: WHAT IS THE EUCHARIST?

One of the Church's newest saints, Carlo Acutis, claimed that we who are alive today are even MORE fortunate than those who got to meet Jesus. That doesn't seem right, does it? How could we be luckier than the people who actually got to see and talk with Jesus?

But even Jesus himself, at the end of the Gospel of John, says, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." How are we, who have not seen Jesus, more blessed than those who walked with him, listened to his teaching, were healed by his own hands?

The answer is the Eucharist. Again, in the Gospel of John, Jesus says, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." In the Eucharist, Jesus remains with us, is present to us in a way that we can not only see, but can receive!

At Mass, through the Power of the Holy Spirit and the ministry of the Priest acting in the person of Christ, Jesus' Incarnation, Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension are all brought into the present for us. These events are not just past, but we live them again and again in every Mass. Unlike those who saw him 2,000 years ago, we can experience his healing love over and over again. This is why what we do in church matters - because Jesus is always with us, on every altar, in every tabernacle, he is really present.


