As we prepare our homes for the coming of Jesus, let's also prepare our inner "home" - our souls - to receive Him! Join us for a night of music & readings as we adore Jesus in the Eucharist. A number of priests will also be available for Confession/Penance/Reconciliation. Before confession, consider:

1. Have I treated people, events, or things as more important than God?
2. Have my words, actively or passively, put down God, the Church, or people?
3. Do I go to Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation? Do I avoid work that impedes joy for the Lord's Day? Do I try to spend time with family or in service on Sunday?
4. Do I show my parents due respect? Do I communicate with them? Do I criticize them for lacking skills I think they should have?
5. Have I harmed another through physical, verbal, or emotional means, *continued* >
6. including gossip or manipulation of any kind?
6. Have I respected the physical and sexual dignity of others and of myself?
7. Have I taken or wasted time or resources that belonged to another?
8. Have I gossiped, told lies, or embellished stories at the expense of another?
9. Have I honored my spouse with my full affection and exclusive love?
10. Am I content with my means and needs, or do I compare myself to others unnecessarily?



HOW-TO CATHOLIC

LIVING AS A EUCHARISTIC CHURCH: WHAT IS MASS?

Have you ever thought how odd it is that the stuff that keeps us alive - our food - is actually dead? That's why we have to keep it in refrigerators! And not only do we eat dead food, but our consumerist culture has stripped away all the spiritually nourishing aspects of eating, the things that bring us joy: preparing something ourselves and enjoying it with others. This is what Jesus comes to save us from: from a world of dead food, of consumerism - of just keeping ourselves barely alive. The Incarnation of Jesus saves us from being an In-Car-Nation of eaters, surviving off the drive-thru!

Mass is the place where we experience Jesus saving us in real time. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, our altar is the Manger of the Nativity, the Table of the Last Supper, it is the Cross of Calvary and the Tomb of the Resurrection. The ambo is the burning bush for Moses, the silent whisper for Elijah, the angel that speaks to Mary and Joseph. Both in His Word and in His Food, God offers his very self to us - we receive the living God at Mass.


But we do not consume these things like we do our usual food. More is required of us at Mass than at the drive-thru. We do not come to Mass as consumers, but as COMMUNICANTS ready to sacrifice our mortal lives to God in order to receive his eternal life in exchange. Most clearly in Mary we see that the disciple of Jesus must offer God all their heart, mind, word, and actions. And that is what we do at Mass! We offer our hearts in our silent prayers and the sign of peace, we offer our minds by letting the readings instruct us, we offer our words in our singing and our Amens, we offer our actions in our standing, bowing, kneeling, and processing. Our participation in Mass teaches us how to offer up our whole lives to God, to be communicants, not just consumers.
