



Advent Journey - Throughout the year our school participates in many service projects. This Christmas season, each of our classrooms have participated in a special project to support those in need. Some highlights include: our third graders brought in an item to donate each Friday in December, Our 6th graders designed a hot chocolate cup with a special message in it for veterans, the Pre 3 and Pre 4 classrooms collected \$300 that was used to purchase items such as cards, dice, pens, candy, notepads, crossword puzzles, popcorn, hot chocolate, oatmeal, lip balm and granola bars. Just as Mass was letting out, some parishioners saw our little elves finishing up and were delighted. And the whole school collected Toys for those in need.

Improvement and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (EITC and the OSTC) programs. Pennsylvania Businesses and Individuals meeting the requirements can apply for EITC or OSTC credits through the PA Department of Community and Economic Development's electronic single application system. This is an excellent way to allow more families to attend our school while receiving a tax credit of up to 90% for your donation. Open House for 2023-2024 School Year & Re-enrollment - This year we have our open house scheduled on Saturday, February 4th from 9 AM - 12 PM. This will be for prospective families to tour the school, ask questions and register their children for the 2023-2024 school year. Volunteers are needed for set up, giving tours, and helping to set up or greet parents. If you are able to volunteer for the event please reach out to Susan Kalich skalich@archanglegabrielpgh.org. (8th graders may earn volunteer hours by giving tours.)



<u>Registration - We will begin the Current Family renewal process on January 23rd. Please look for information coming soon for this process.</u> Note that the **New Family** registration will begin at our Open House and spots will be filled on a first come first served basis so we encourage all current families to secure spots as soon as possible. Please look for communication that will be coming out soon. In the meantime, please make sure your FACTS account is up to date.

REGISTRATION SAVE THE DATES:

Beginning January 23rd

<u>Grades K-7</u>- A simple online renewal form will be made available to each of our families who currently have students in grades K-7 and are advancing to 1-8. An administrative fee (formerly registration fee) per family will be added to your FACTS account in the spring. The fee is estimated to be \$125 per family and the region will supply us with this amount as soon they can. If you are adding a new student (sibling), you will need to fill out a full enrollment application for your additional child. (If for any reason your child is not able to attend AGS for the 2023-2024 school year, please notify the school office ASAP.)

AGS Preschool/New Kindergarten Enrollment: - A full enrollment application will be made available on January 23rd for our current preschool families who are interested in attending Preschool or Kindergarten for the 2023-2024 school year. Each of our current families will have at least one full week preference before new AGS families are able to enroll. If you are adding a sibling from your family, you will be able to do so at that time. For all Preschool, Kindergarten and New students to AGS, a \$100 non-refundable tuition down payment fee will be required per family via check made out to "Archangel Gabriel Catholic School". This fee will be applied to your tuition for the 2023-2024 school year. Additionally, an administrative fee (formerly registration fee) will be added to each families' FACTS accounts. The fee is estimated to be \$125 per family and the region will supply us with this amount as soon they can.

IMPORTANT 2022-2023 Registration dates:

January 2nd – Early registration for Kindergarten 2023-2024 with an AGS pack including math and reading learning center kits – *online application available on our website on January 2nd*.

January 23rd – Current Family renewal and "add a sibling" registration – *online form available on our website by January 23rd, information will also be emailed out via OptionC.*

January 30th – Two-year commitment application accepted for new families entering an AGS 4 year old preschool class for 2023-2024 school year plus committing to attend AGS Kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year. A \$500 scholarship will be applied to the 2024-2025 tuition for those accepted. *Online applications will be available soon.* (First come, first served)

February 4th – Open House 9 AM–12 PM – Open Application and New Family Registration – Printed applications only will be accepted this day for those who wish to apply to Pre 3 – Grade 8. Link for open house tour sign-ups will be available on our website soon.

February 6th – Beginning this day both physical and online applications will be accepted for new family enrollment for Pre 3 – Grade 8 students for the 2023-2024 school year.

We encourage all families to be advocates for our school by sharing your positive experiences with friends and families in the community. This will help us to keep our school strong and let new prospects learn about our school.
